DANGERSTRANGULATION HAZARD

- Keep cords out of the reach of
- Move cribs and furniture away from cords.
- Remove objects below windows.
- Loops will appear when the shade is in the raised position.
- Do not tie cords together.







Install a cord tensioner or cord cleat.



EMERGENCY FIRST AID FOR STRANGULATION



- Remove cord from child's neck • Call 911 or Emergency Center
- Clear throat
- Check breathing and heart beat
- Begin CPR

Important Information

Please read the Window Covering Manufacturers Association, Inc. warning included in these instructions, on the tag attached to the lift cords and on the permanent label on the bottom rail of your shade. Do not remove the permanent label. This assures that future owners of this product will be aware of potential dangers associated with shade cords and children.



Before you begin your installation:

Read all installation instructions before you

- Make sure that you have all tools and hardware needed for installation.
- Check the installation surface (wall, ceiling, or window frame) to ensure that you have suitable fasteners and tools for the material.
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
IMPORTANT:

The four cords on your shade do not operate the shade. They are used to suspend the shade within a circular window, and are needed for final installation.


Do not remove them from the shade. If any of the cords fall out, simply fan the shade open and thread the cord(s) through the cells at an equal distance from each other.

Expand the shade

· The fabric is cut to the proper length, with doublesided tape preinstalled on one end. Remove the backing from the double-sided tape.



. Being careful not to trap the strings in the tape, fan the shade open around the center plug to form a circle. Press the ends firmly together.



Mounting Options

Your shade can be installed as either an:

Inside mount (2A)—the entire shade fits inside the window casing, or an

Outside mount (2B)—the shade attaches to the wall around the window.

The mounting type is specified when ordering the shade, and determines where the T-pins are installed.



· Once the shade is in the desired location, tie the cords to the T-pins.



Care and cleaning

- Like any piece of fine furniture, your shade should be dusted regularly. Use a brush-type vacuum attachment or feather duster for dusting; stroke lightly over the shade.
- To clean with water, use a damp sponge and
- Avoid contact with window cleaning products.
- · Do not immerse shade in water.

Installing the T-pins inside mount

. Using the tape measure and pencil, mark mounting locations for the T-pins at the top, bottom, and each side of the window casing. Be sure to space them at an equal distance from

each other and from the window. Using a tack hammer, attach the T-pins at the marked

locations.
